

### Meet and Greets

Your child will have an opportunity to meet his/her new teacher on Monday, August 24<sup>th</sup> ! During Meet and Greets this year you will complete the District Data Verification and Health Information forms.

Monday, August 24<sup>th</sup> Meet and Greets at the classrooms:

Kindergarten: 2pm-2:30 pm

First Grade: 8:30am-9:00am

Second Grade: Hirsh/Dehne, Booth, Peterson, Seely: 12pm -1pm

Second Grade: Horwitz, Smith, Mazzoncini, Cressey: 3pm-4pm

### Morning Drop Off Procedures

All yards will have supervision from 7:55am until the beginning of school at 8:25. The following rules apply all year:

- Kindergarten and First Graders (except Santana's class): Please walk your child to the kindergarten or first grade yard. If you drop off in front of the school, please tell your child to report to their playground. Teachers will come out to meet their classes after the first morning bell rings at 8:23. **Students are not to wait/play outside and around classroom doors, patios and ramps.**
- Second Grade and Mrs. Santana's First Grade Class: Children are to play on the second grade yard until the first bell rings at 8:23. Teachers will come out to meet their classes.

### After School Pick Up Procedures

There are only three options for pick up after school:

- 1. Carpool:** Go online to [laurelpto.org](http://laurelpto.org) to sign up for a carpool number. You will need a number card to drive through the pick-up lane after school (for the first couple weeks, just drive through the carpool lane to pick up your child without a number card).
- 2. Bus:** There are numerous bus options – Newton, Tinsley, Our School, Rec Van, etc. Please be sure your child's teacher knows which bus s/he will take.
- 3. Arbor:** ALL teachers walk their classes to the second grade arbor area after school. If your child is not going home either through carpool or a bus, s/he must be picked up at the arbor.

Reminder: Always send a note to your child's teacher if you plan to change your pick-up routine.
